

# FRENCH HORN FINGERING CHART

Use the top fingering if you play an F horn. Use the fingering in parentheses if you play a B $\flat$  horn. Use either fingering if you play a double horn. Depress the thumb valve to switch from the F side to the B $\flat$  side of your double horn.
